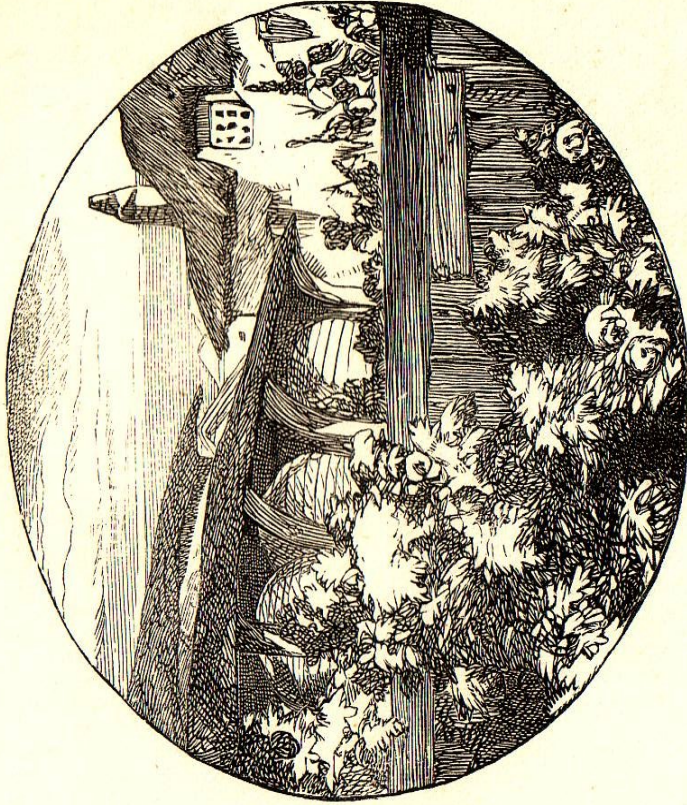
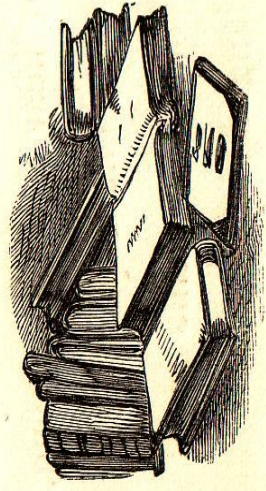


DIVINE SONGS.
