

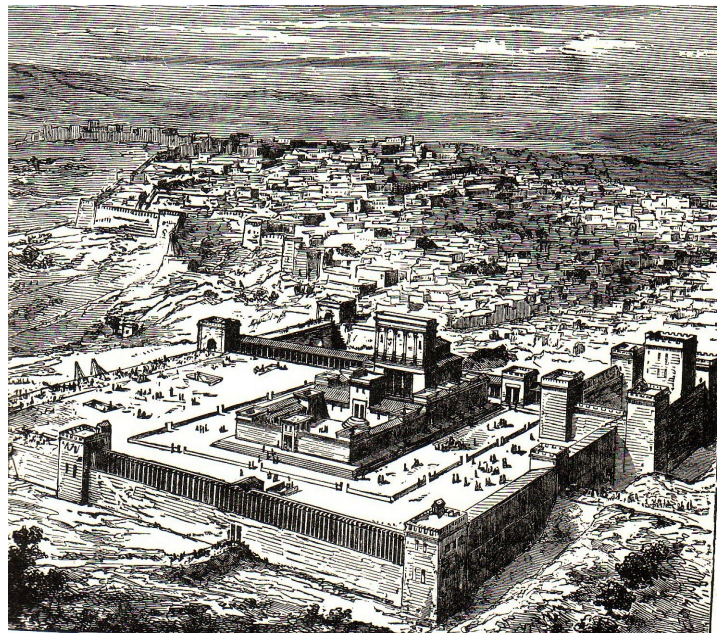
THE LIFE OF OUR LORD
