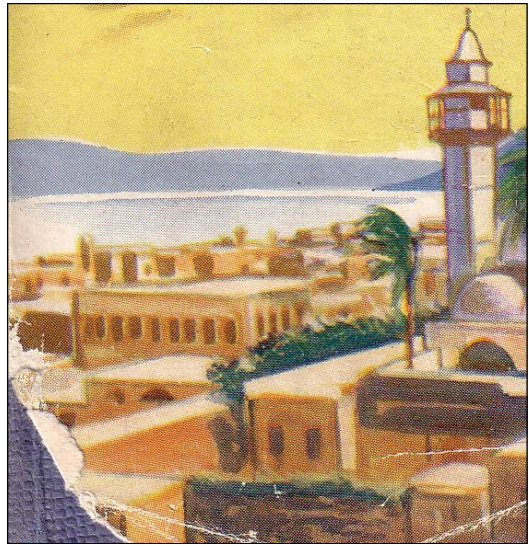


Henry Groves
